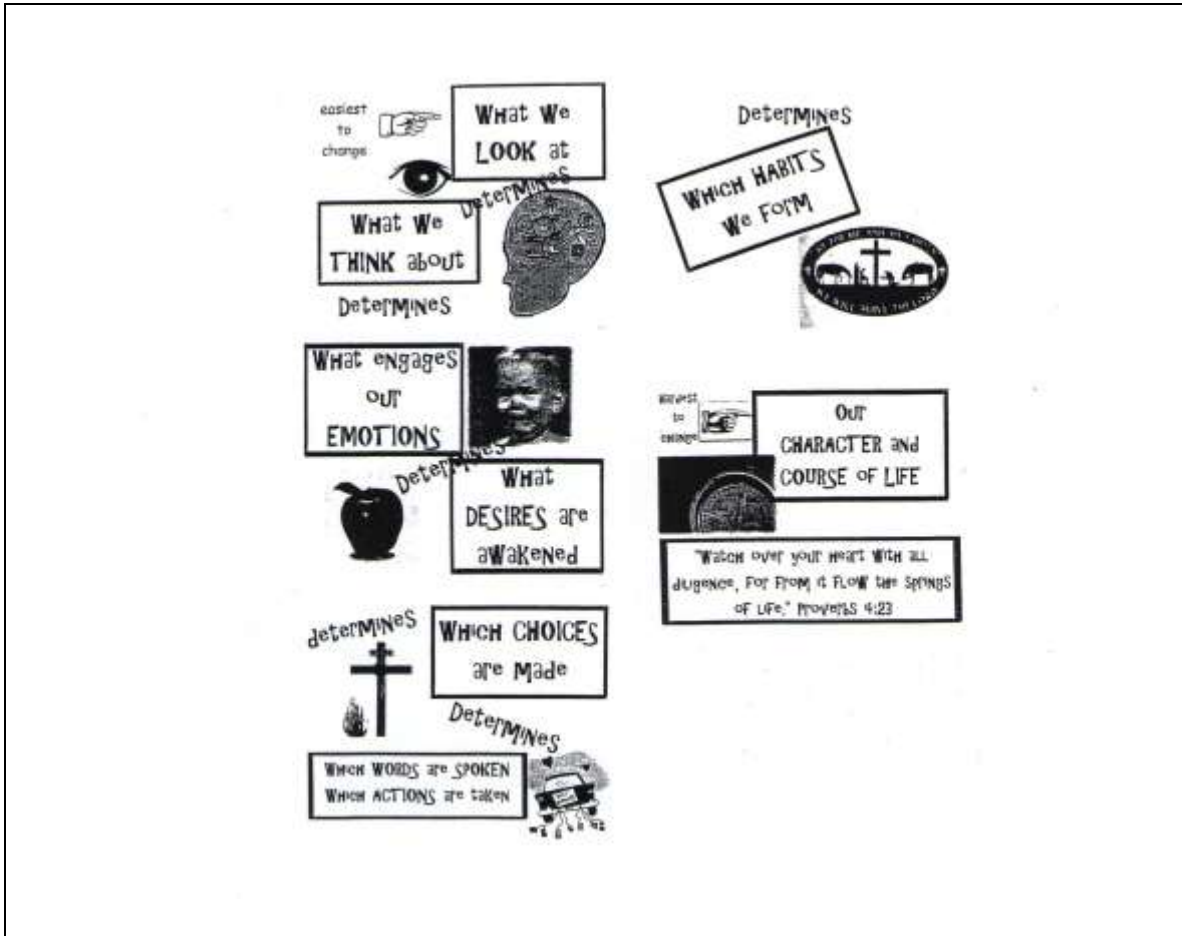

For many years now, the following chart has hung in our lodge and in a classroom. We decided to make it our focus for this fall’s Family Resolve under the title of “Thinking Matters.”



One of our young men designed the cover of the Resolve booklet showing all the outside influences and distractions that hook our thinking through our five senses. Interestingly, our technological advancements provide some of our greatest challenges to good thinking. Jim (my husband) developed the theme in the introductory session, pointing out that from the beginning people have been to think right. Adam and Eve failed and so do we. Galatians 5:19 listing the sins of the flesh was used as a self-evaluation for our thinking.

The second session focused on the remedy for good thinking. For the cover sheet of this session, the same young man drew a simple picture of a person in a worshipful posture receiving rays of light from above. The contrast with the first “busy” cover was clear and the remedy Jim presented was to “Be still and know that I am God.” Ps. 46:10. Also Galatians 5:22-23 (fruit of the Spirit) and Philippians 4:8 were given as a standard for measuring good thinking. Underlining

the importance of thinking right, testimonies were given by Flying H graduate Robert Popi, staff member Amber Rodriguez, and kitchen volunteer from Calvary Chapel Vancouver Chuck Rogers.

Lest you think our weekend consisted of a series of lectures and testimonies, I must tell you that we enjoyed apple cider pressing (we drank about 20 gallons of fresh cider throughout the weekend), eating delicious meals, presentations by boys of their vocational projects and poetry recitation, parent-teacher conferences, and fellowship among parents and staff.
